

ARTICLES GOVERNING THE ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE
AUBURN/WILLIAMS RECREATION ASSOCIATION

Article I

The committee shall be known as the Auburn/Williams Recreation Association.

Article II

The purpose of the association shall be to plan and promote recreation and the needed facilities for such within the Township of Williams and the City of Auburn, in the County of Bay.

Article III

The association shall consist of ten permanent members. Five shall be appointed by the Auburn City Commission and five members shall be appointed by the Williams Township Board.

Article IV

A member may be removed from the association by a majority vote of the other members for the following reasons:

1. Absent from three consecutive meetings without a valid reason.
2. Members working against the best interest of the association.

Article V

No member shall hold an elective office within the City of Auburn or the Township of Williams.

Article VI

The officers of the association shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. Term of office shall be for a period of one year.

Article VII

The election of officers shall be held at the first regular meeting in January of each year.

Article VIII

In case of a resignation of a member the vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the Auburn City Commission or the Williams Township Board, depending upon the residence of the resigned member.

Article IX

The President may appoint such committees as he deems necessary.

Article X

The regular meeting of the association shall be held on the third (3rd) Wednesday of every other month. Special meetings may be scheduled by the President.

Article XI

All members shall be notified of special meetings in advance by the Secretary.

Article XII

A majority of the association may transact official business of the association at all scheduled or special meetings.

Article XIII

Duties of the Association

Section 1. - To organize, plan and promote recreation within the City of Auburn and the Township of Williams.

Section 2. - To administer the spending of money allotted to them for recreational purposes, unless otherwise specified.

Section 3. - To promote additional recreational facilities.

Section 4. - To prepare an estimated annual budget at the regular September meeting of each year. Copies shall be submitted to the Auburn City Commission and the Williams Township Board.

Article XIV

All monies raised privately by organizations operating under the jurisdiction of the association shall be considered the property of the organizations and may be used at their discretion. Monies contributed to the association by these organizations may be used at the discretion of the association.

Article XV

All articles contained herein may be amended by majority vote of members of the association.
