

RFP Auburn Park, Jaycee Dr.

The City of Auburn's DDA is requesting bids to improve Jaycee Drive as part of the Auburn City Park improvement plan. The City of Auburn's DDA is requesting the cost for the following:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Construct the Jaycee Drive with a recycled bituminous surface, concrete curb and gutter with storm sewers to drain the road. The project limits are from Station 10+81 to Station 17+20 with an additional 50-foot transition to the existing road.

SCOPE OF PROJECT:

1. Remove and dispose of existing pavement and concrete within the project limits shown to be removed. Disposal off site
2. Remove and dispose of the wood post shown on the plans within the project limits. Disposal off site
3. Other removal as required for construction. An item **not** to be removed is the Veterans Memorial. After construction staking the design will be modified as required to not disturb the Memorial.
4. Equipment and labor to remove stone from areas which would not allow a minimum 12" sand subbase over the existing gravel in areas that require a subbase "Build up" of 4 inches or greater. Replace the removed stone on sand and compact prior to placing the asphalt millings. The asphalt millings are located east of the project in Auburn Park.
5. Supply and place sand in the areas needed.
6. Prepare curb base with 12-inch minimum sand.
7. Install 12-inch drains from structure 1 to 2, 2 to 2A
8. Place 18 foot of 15-inch drain from structure 2 to the east (plans show 12-inch drain)
9. Install 12-inch drain (not shown on the plans) between 2A to 3B and 3B to the existing basin 726.
10. Relocate asphalt millings over subgrade, grade and compact the millings.
11. Supply and install backfill material from back of curb to existing grade.
12. Coordinate work with the Concrete curb contractor.
13. Traffic control items will be by the owner.
14. Fencing of the play area if required will be by the Owner.

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

Restricted access to the park during construction must be coordinated with the City. The completion date is November 21, 2018. The DDA has a Fall Festival on October 27, 2018 park access is required for this event.

We propose to award the contract for the project on or before October 16, 2018.

Sealed bids must be received by the City of Auburn, 113 Elm St., Auburn MI. 48611 by 1:00 PM Thursday October 10, 2018. The project is a Lump sum Bid. Provide lineal foot price for soil erosion control fence to be paid and placed only if required. The City is in the process of obtaining the soil permit for the project.
