



In Spring 2020, the City of Auburn was awarded a grant from the Bay Area Community Foundation Healthy Living Fund to develop a new, exciting project: THE RANGE MULTI-USE PARK. Within this 25-acre multi-use, all-season park will feature a professionally designed 18-hole disc golf course, a sledding hill with adjacent bonfire area, cross country biking trails and a wooded sanctuary for walking/dog walking and cross-country ski/snowshoe activities. Adding these recreation opportunities to the park will increase its multi-functionality and provide year-round use and make it “family and fur-friendly”.

The disc golf course will be designed to host Professional Disc Golf Association (PDGA) tournaments which will be a source of revenue that will be used to support The Range. Due to its location, and in conjunction with several other Michigan courses, this course will complete a 'circuit' necessary to bring professional tournaments to this area. Each 'hole' will have 2 tees, a short one for novice players and a longer one for advanced players.

Levels 1 & 2 (Power Shot and Fairway Shot) receive recognition at the hole of choice. Choice of hole is at a first come, first served basis. Levels 1 & 2 will also receive recognition on the park’s Donor Wall . Levels 3 & 4 (Flex Shot and Putt) will receive recognition on the park’s Donor Wall.
